- The Jandakot Airport Master Plan 2014 was approved by the Minister for Infrastructure and Regional Development on 17 February 2015
- An exposure draft Master Plan 2019 was sent to DIRD in December. DIRD comments have been addressed. The minister for Infrastructure has granted an extension for the submission of the Master Plan until June 2021
