Note: Last Airservices records didn't include training circuits and data may not include movements outside tower hours • Airservices would like to show circuit training in a separate report to record more accurate data • Comparable Airports - Compared Jandakot, Archerfield, Moorabbin, Parafield & Bankstown – Most complaints for night movements and emergency movements at night except Jandakot who received complaints mostly for GA ops movements. AVIATION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • RFDS – Apron for helicopter operations is open for daytime use. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Once lighting stock arrives and is installed, apron will be open for night operations also. • Runway 12/30 - Threshold may need to be temporarily displaced for construction activities.
