Jandakot Airport Holdings is committed to providing a safe working and operating environment for our employees, contractors, tenants and those who visit Jandakot Airport. Safety is an integral component of all aerodrome activities.

To achieve our commitment, we will:

- Promote the management of safety as a responsibility of all managers and employees.
- Provide necessary resources to support this policy and to achieve the outcomes of the safety management system.
- Seek to comply with relevant legislative and regulatory requirements and standards.
- Establish and measure our safety performance against realistic objectives.
- Establish and maintain risk management processes to eliminate or mitigate safety risks at the aerodrome.
- Promote a no blame reporting culture where individuals are encouraged to report safety concerns through the safety management system.
- Provide employees with adequate and appropriate safety training and information to conduct their work safely.
- Support regular effective communication to all employees, contractors, and relevant stakeholders.
- Promote the maintenance of a safe work environment to all employees, tenants and airport operators through compliance with approved policies, procedures and training.
- Ensure appropriate investigation of incidents, accidents and near misses is conducted and corrective actions implemented, to prevent re-occurrence.
- Conduct regular reviews to ensure the ongoing effectiveness of the safety management system.
