Quarter three 2019

- There were 27 complainants during quarter three 2019 which is an increase from 12 complainants in quarter two. For the same period in 2018, there were 17 complainants.
- Complaints are counted based on the reporter and the incident type. The same person (complainant) can report a different occurrence type and that will be counted as another complaint by the same complainant.
- There has been an increase in traffic numbers this quarter compared to the same period in 2018, and an increase in complainants affected by emergency services operations.

4. Jandakot Airport Update

4.1. MASTER PLAN

- The Jandakot Airport Master Plan was approved by the Minister for Infrastructure and Regional Development on 17 February 2015
- The ANEF has been endorsed by Airservices Australia
- An exposure draft Master Plan 2019 was sent to DIRD in December. Comments are currently being addressed. As this draft Master Plan has been delayed, a request has been sent to the Minister to extend the timeframe for Master Plan 2014.

4.2. INFRASTRUCTURE

• JAH has agreed to partial funding of the Karel Avenue Upgrade Project. The contractor has commenced work on site. Completion is expected in 14 months.

4.3. AVIATION

• The extension of runway 12/30 and the new airport lighting are both operational.

4.4. COMMERCIAL

- Site 1 Construction has commenced on 1,600m² office and 3000m² laboratory
- Site 207 Work has commenced on a 10,000m² work with a 1,500m² office.
- Site 216 Construction has commenced on a 1,200m² office and a 18,000m² warehouse.
