NCIS Update

- Complainant numbers across Australia increased from April to June as more people worked from home
- General aviation complaints increased especially around circuit and other training activities Australia wide
- Complainant numbers have remained steady for Jandakot.
- From March to July there were 75 complaints over 37 suburbs with Baldivis, Canning vale and Jandakot recording the most complaints

4. Jandakot Airport Update

4.1. MASTER PLAN

- The Jandakot Airport Master Plan 2014 was approved by the Minister for Infrastructure and Regional Development on 17 February 2015
- An exposure draft Master Plan 2019 was sent to DIRD in December. DIRD comments are currently being addressed. The minister for Infrastructure has granted an extension for the submission of the Master Plan until December 2020

4.2. INFRASTRUCTURE

• JAH has agreed to partial funding of the Karel Avenue Upgrade Project. Completion is delayed and is now expected in July 2021

4.3. AVIATION

• Taxiway Bravo and other minor taxiway maintenance works are scheduled to take place in November 2020

4.4. COMMERCIAL

• Site 1 – Construction has commenced on 1,600m² office and 3000m² laboratory
