2019 Overview

- There were 78 individual complainants in 2019.
- The main issues in 2019 were general aviation traffic, training, and helicopters
- General aviation traffic affected 47 percent of complainants in 2019. The majority of these were either emergency services operations (46 percent) or standard operations (49 percent).
- Helicopters were a concern to 19 percent of the complainants in 2019, All but one of these were emergency services operations.
- Training affected 23 percent of complainants in 2019. All but one of these were concerned with circuit training.

4. Jandakot Airport Update

4.1. MASTER PLAN

- The Jandakot Airport Master Plan 2014 was approved by the Minister for Infrastructure and Regional Development on 17 February 2015
- The ANEF has been endorsed by Airservices Australia
- An exposure draft Master Plan 2019 was sent to DIRD in December. DIRD Comments are currently being addressed. The minister for Infrastructure has granted an extension for the submission of the Master Plan until December 2020
- Estimated mid-year for public comment.

4.2. INFRASTRUCTURE

 JAH has agreed to partial funding of the Karel Avenue Upgrade Project. The contractor has commenced work on site. Completion is delayed by 6 months and is expected in December 2020.

4.3. AVIATION

 Taxiway Bravo and other minor taxiway maintenance works are scheduled to take place from May to July.

4.4. COMMERCIAL

- Site 1 Construction has commenced on 1,600m² office and 3000m² laboratory
- Site 207 Work is almost complete on a 10,000m2 workshop with a 1,500m2 office
- Site 216 Construction is almost complete on a 1,200m² office and a 18,000m² warehouse.
- Site 10B Construction will commence on a 17,000m2 handstand
