**Note 1 - Application fee**

In accordance with Regulation 2.02(1), an application fee is required to be paid to the “Department of Infrastructure, Regional Development and Cities” (to be collected by the Airport Building Controller) prior to the issue of the Demolition Authorisation. The basis for calculation of that fee is set out in Regulation 2.02.

**Note 2 - AAT Review**

Under Regulation 5.02 the applicant for the approval may make application to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal to have the decision of the Airport Building Controller to refuse or fail to approve a building activity reviewed.
