<p>City of Melville councillor (J. Spanbroek) has raised the previously discussed topic of concerns from residents regarding pilots not remaining within the flight paths around the Winthrop area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> S Klomp has been in communication with residents regarding this topic over the past few months and proposed two options: invite a representative onto the committee or draft up a letter for the committee to review and consider distributing to known operators at Jandakot Airport. City of Melville and the group of residents have acknowledged that the flight paths cannot be changed, they just want to ensure pilots are complying. It is crucial to remember that the JA CACG is a consultation group, not a statutory authority. The group of residents have not formed an official community / resident group, this would need to occur to join the committee and would be limited to a maximum of two representatives at the meeting. A draft letter will be sent to the CACG Secretariat to distribute to the committee for review. Based on the outcome it may be send out after the next CACG Meeting in September. H Johnson (Airservices - Community engagement) has referred to the aircraft in your neighbourhood page on Airservices Australia website.
