Emergency services continued to be the dominant source of noise complaints. 8. Department of Infrastructure	
<p>8.1. Commonwealth PFAS Investigation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Up to 37 airports are in scope for the PFAS Airports Investigation Program administered by the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts. The Program seeks to determine that nature and extent of PFAS on airport and any potential migration pathways off airport. Investigations are currently underway across 16 airport sites, including Jandakot Airport, and all investigations are expected to be complete by June 2027. Initial fieldworks and sampling at Jandakot Airport were undertaken between December 2024 and February 2025. Water Use Surveys were sent in December 2024, and January 2025, to approximately 150 properties not connected to mains water adjacent to Jandakot Airport. The Department’s consultants have been in the field since 21 February 2025 discussing the WUS with residents and, where residents consent, taking water, soil, and biota samples from properties. Residents will be provided with the results from their property along with any associated guidance/advice from relevant WA Agencies. Following the Detailed Site Investigation and any Human Health and Ecological Risk Assessment, a PFAS Management Plan will be developed setting out appropriate management actions to address identified risks (expected by mid-2026). Regular updates will continue to be provided via this forum and on the Jandakot investigation webpage on the Department’s website.
